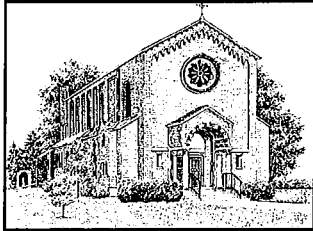

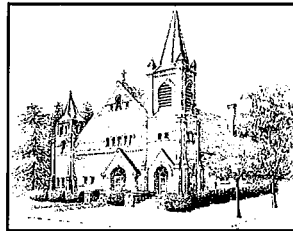

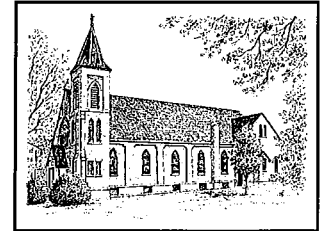

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

*Almighty and merciful God,
may no earthly undertaking hinder those
who set out in haste to meet your Son,
but may our learning of heavenly wisdom
gain us admittance to his company. Who lives and reigns....*

I hope this Advent Season has begun well for you as we make our way towards Christmas, and with the celebration of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary this week.

I want to continue looking at the opening Collect for Mass, as I did last week, but now we have another layer added to last week's theme. Here in the Second Sunday of Advent, we remember last week how the Collect, and Jesus in the Gospel, spoke to us about the suddenness of the coming Judgment as well our need to run to meet Christ with righteous deeds. The same is true in this week's Collect, yet now we have a better idea of *how* we prepare for the coming of Christ.

We have two points that draw our attention. First, we pray that *no earthly undertaking hinder* us who have now set out to go meet Christ. So, the image here that is given to us in the beginning of the Collect is that we have now all set out on this journey, and we have to be sure to stay on the path. Since this path is the road to heaven, towards Christ who is to come, then veering off that path would be disastrous. How could that happen? By allowing some *earthly undertaking* to distract us from our goal.

It is very easy, in the busy-ness of daily life, to lose track of what God is trying to say to us, the various graces He is giving us. This is why we have liturgical seasons to prepare for great feasts, such as Advent/Christmas and Lent/Easter. The change of seasons (and of some scenery in our churches) wakes us up to the fact that something is different about this time, and so we pay attention. On the positive side, we can and must use the things of this world to help us on this path toward heaven. What that means is that instead of seeing the things of our daily life as distractions from moving towards our goal of heaven, we should see everything as an *opportunity* to grow in some virtue, to continue down this path toward heaven.

The second way this collect proposes for us to continue on this path is *to learn of heavenly wisdom*. I see two meanings of "heavenly wisdom." First, our Lord Jesus Christ is the Incarnate *Word* of God. The Second Person of the Trinity, the Word/Son of God is there from all eternity with the Father and Holy Spirit. It is through the Word that all things were made. He is the Wisdom of the Father, the *eternal thought* of the Father. To learn from Him, from Jesus, is eternal life: "Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the one whom you sent, Jesus Christ" (John 17:3).

And yet there is another aspect to "heavenly wisdom" that I see here, and it comes within the context of the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary this week (December 8). In the older Mass, the first reading is taken from Proverbs 8, referred to as the "Discourse of Wisdom." Here is part of that text used for the Mass of the Immaculate Conception: "Now, children, listen to me; happy are they who keep my ways. Listen to instruction and grow wise, do not reject it! Happy the one who listens to me, attending daily at my gates, keeping watch at my doorposts; For whoever finds me finds life, and wins favor from the Lord" (Proverbs 8:32-35). The Church has seen in such texts a reference to Mary because God had known her in His mind long before she was born, before she was immaculately conceived. She was to be the New Eve, to begin the restoration of humanity. It is through her that the Savior would come to us.

She is also the perfect disciple. Every word and every interior movement of hers is in perfect accord with the will of God. We listen to Mary because she allows us to listen to Our Lord. She always points to him, as we see at the Wedding at Cana: "Do whatever he tells you" (John 2:5). We go to Jesus through Mary. We find her, we find Life, eternal life in Christ Our Lord.
