STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be held on **Fridays** during Lent beginning this **Fri., Feb. 16th** at **St. Dominic Church** at **6:30 pm**.

Lent is a time for Prayer, Fasting & Abstinence. The following are the Church's Lenten regulations:

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday—These are days of **Fast & Abstinence from meat**. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive.

All Fridays of Lent—Fridays of Lent are days of **Abstinence from Meat**. All who are 14 and older are bound to *abstain* totally from meat.

Other Weekdays of Lent—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial (like giving up something difficult) are recommended.
