**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

Continuing the discussion on scrupulosity, we have to make a distinction between a *scrupulous* conscience and a *delicate* and *tender* conscience. As mentioned last week, a scrupulous conscience seeks absolute certainty of one's state of grace. This is simply not possible. Our good God does not make it so difficult for us to be at peace. We examine our conscience according to the teaching of the Church (following the Ten Commandments, precepts of the Church, etc.) which can be found in a good Examination sheet or pamphlet or even app on a phone. Then we bring these things to a confessor and trust his judgement. It is OK to ask questions and make distinctions, but also important to abide by his judgment, for the sake of your conscience. If, after an examination of conscience and seeking the advice of a confessor we find no mortal sin, then we must be at peace and trust in the mercy of God, as we do with our whole life.

God certainly does not want to deceive us, but He wants to lead us to peace. The burden is also on the confessor to know the proper teaching and practice of the Church, and to help the penitent live by them through good counsel and dispensing all the means of grace at his disposal as a priest.

While someone with a scrupulous conscience starts at the point of the self, looking for that security in such certainty that cannot be attained, the person with a *delicate* conscience loves God as his starting point, and desires to please Him through good works and avoidance of any fault. Such a conscience knows its weakness in the face of the dangers that come to it from the world, the flesh, and the devil, and so seeks solace in the merciful God who made him, relying on His help in all things: "I am the vine; you the branches: he that abideth in me, and I in him, the same beareth much fruit: for without me you can do nothing" (John 15:5).

There are many topics about which someone may be scrupulous, for example: worried about past confessions even after multiple general confessions while not actually having anything the penitent left out of the confession; certain evil thoughts even though the penitent was displeased with those thoughts and sought to reject them; sins against the virtue of charity (neglecting fraternal correction, listening to gossip without protest, etc.). What we can call a *tender* conscience is able to discern in these cases are venial sins. Yes, they are good to bring to confession so God will strengthen us against them the next time we face such temptations or situations. Yet we must fundamentally trust God as our loving Father who sees our trials and gives us His grace in the midst of them.

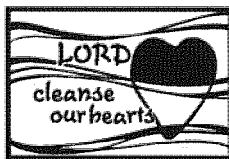
But why would God allow us to undergo such trials? Why does He not just give us perfect knowledge of the state of our soul? We must first learn to see such trials for the purification of our souls. We can choose to avoid any sin for the love of God and so acquire purity of heart. We learn humility by experiencing the loss of peace when we have not yet relied on the help of God. We learn patience along with humility by realizing that we too are quite fallible, and so extend that patience to others. Finally, such trials purify our intentions by allowing us to learn to cling solely to God for whom our love must continue to grow.
