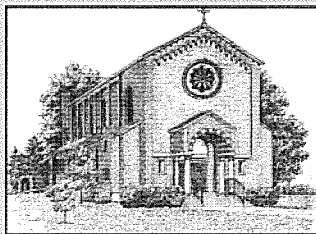


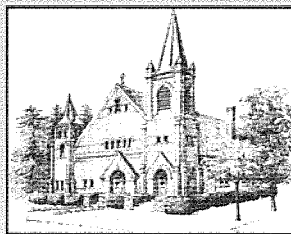

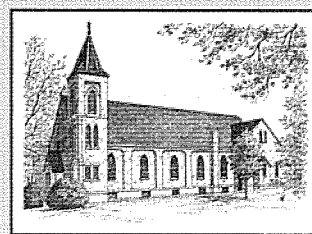

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

This week, we come to the very heart of the Roman Canon. In a sense, we enter in to the Holy of Holies where God truly lives. While all the prayers surrounding the Consecration are important in each of the Eucharistic Prayers, it is the following set of words, particularly those words in all capitals (this is how they appear in the Missal) that must be said for the validity of the Sacrament:

"On the day before he was to suffer he took bread in his holy and venerable hands, and with eyes raised to heaven to you, O God, his almighty Father, giving you thanks he said the blessing, broke the bread and gave it to his disciples, saying: TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND EAT OF IT, FOR THIS IS MY BODY, WHICH WILL BE GIVEN UP FOR YOU.

In a similar way, when supper was ended, he took this precious chalice in his holy and venerable hands, and once more giving you thanks, he said the blessing and gave the chalice to his disciples, saying: TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND DRINK FROM IT, FOR THIS IS THE CHALICE OF MY BLOOD, THE BLOOD OF THE NEW AND ETERNAL COVENANT, WHICH WILL BE Poured OUT FOR YOU AND FOR MANY FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS. DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME."

One thing you may notice is that these words of Consecration are not taken perfectly from any one source in Scripture. We can see elements taken from Matthew 26:26-28, Mark 14:22-24, Luke 22:19-20, and 1 Corinthians 11:23-26. While these parts of Scripture do not agree in every detail, the essence is the same, relating what Our Lord did on that evening of the Last Supper, and what priests will do in His name and in commemoration of Him until the end of the world.

After the words of Consecration are pronounced by the priest over the bread and the wine, he elevates each in turn so that the people may adore. This practice developed over the centuries as our Eucharistic devotion grew and developed. In God's Providence, as He has guided His Church throughout the centuries, we came to take those few moments in adoration of our Eucharistic Lord. At that moment, heaven and earth are united. Our God has come to us.

We should look upon Him at that moment as if we are truly kneeling at the foot of the Cross on Golgotha. His Body is broken for us; His Precious Blood is poured out for us. We have the privilege to participate in this perfect Sacrifice of the Son to the Father.

We will see, as we go forward, the symmetry of the Roman Canon in its structure and prayers. At this point, we see Jesus truly present under the Sacramental veil. Bread and wine are no longer present, but the Body and Blood of Christ. Now the priest will offer the Divine Victim; the Son to the Father; God to God.

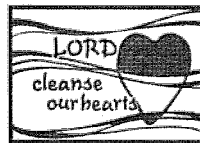
