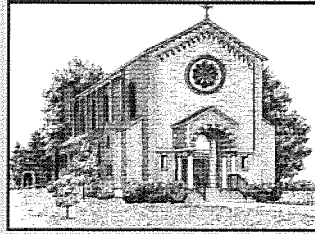
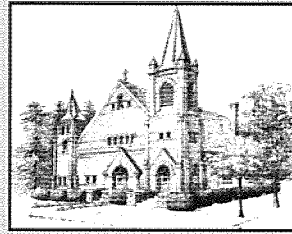


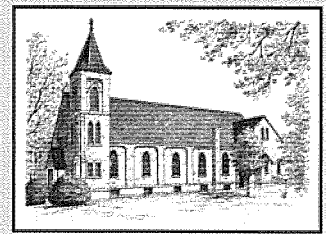

**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

Continuing from where we left off last week, when I wrote about how to participate at Mass, I now want to talk about the effects of receiving Holy Communion. There is no greater participation in the Mass than to consume the One who was Sacrificed on the altar. While it is true that our obligation is fulfilled each week by being at Mass and participating to the extent we are able, we should always strive to be in a state such that we can receive Holy Communion worthily.

But why? What do we "get out of it"? We tend to think in such "practical" terms, but there is nothing more practical and beneficial for our immortal soul than its union with God. The soul's union with God is *real* and *spiritual*. We are not merely united to Jesus by shared sentiments or ideas, such as we would be in a club or a group sharing a hobby. We are united to Him *physically* because the Sacred Host is His *Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity*, given to us as our food. The difference – using the analogy of food – is that while the physical species (bread) is assimilated into our body like any other food, since the very substance of God is present, we *are assimilated into Him*. He makes us like Himself. This is how we can say that, while the physical species of the bread is within us, we are truly a living tabernacle: "He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, abideth in me, and I in him" (John 6:57).

The *spiritual* aspect of this union with God is also *transforming*. We are made to become like Him. Since we receive the "whole Christ" in Holy Communion, we are receiving His soul, which seeks to make us one heart and one mind with Him. His human mind and memory (which is forever united to the Divine Nature) unite to our own to turn them towards God. Just as in the human soul of Christ, He was constantly turned towards the loving gaze of His Father, so by Jesus living within our soul, He brings it about that we too are turned more towards Him, and we are able to value all things as God sees them. His will, as well, comes to us to correct our weaknesses, to make us strong, constant, and determined to grow in the virtues we need.

Of course, the Sacred Host, the species of bread, does not remain in us forever. We have maybe ten or fifteen minutes before our body sufficiently dissolves the species. What remains? The Holy Spirit who filled the human soul of Jesus – who was substantially present in the Host – now remains in us by this special relationship we entered into with Jesus in Holy Communion. But the Persons of the Most Holy Trinity do not act alone. The Most Holy Trinity, God, truly lives within us: "If any one loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him, and will make our abode with him" (John 14:23). This is the promise given to us by the Savior. Each time we receive Holy Communion, we have a renewal of our life with God, a foretaste of heavenly glory.
