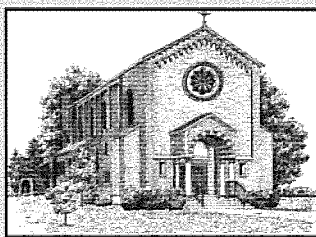
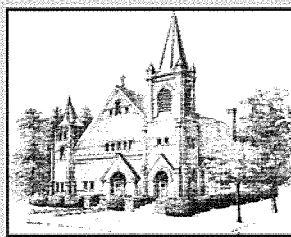


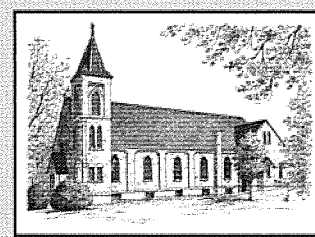

**ST. PETER'S ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH at the CHURCHES of ST. DOMINIC, ST. FELIX, and ST. FRANCIS  
FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

After discussing what is actually happening in our soul when we receive Holy Communion, it is important to finally discuss how to approach this Sacrament so that we can gain the most profit from receiving Him.

It starts, first, with our *preparation*. We come to Mass anticipating the intimate union with our Lord in Holy Communion. Of course, we must already be in a state of grace (the in-dwelling of the Holy Trinity in our soul), and not conscious of any grave sin, if we are to receive Communion. Otherwise, sacramental Confession would be required. I certainly try to make the sacrament of Confession readily available. So, the examination of conscience is a good form of preparation for the reception of Holy Communion.

Also, by way of preparation, we should always strive to perform the duties of our particular state of life in union with Jesus and in order to please Him. Such works are *meritorious* and lead us closer to God. Humility is another disposition we must foster within us as we approach our Lord. In order to grow in humility, we reflect on the perfect sanctity and life of Jesus, recognizing how we ourselves fall so short: "Lord and I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof...". This ties in to the attentiveness that we should have at Mass regarding all the prayers and our responses. This kind of humility is something that we can and should pray for, since it comes from God. Its purpose is to empty us of ourselves – our pride and presumption – so that we are then filled by God.

We must desire to be united to God in the Eucharist. We bring this desire to every Mass, not merely by way of obligation, but out of a true love for our Savior. We long for Him who alone gives strength to our weakness. We are coming to meet Jesus, and He is coming to meet us.

After Communion, we must be sure to make a *thanksgiving*. Remember, the Lord is *substantially* present within us for about 10-15 minutes – for as long as the species of bread remains. Do we not have something we want to say to our God who humbled Himself to become our food? This is why it is so sad for me to see people walk out of the church immediately after receiving Holy Communion. Our Eucharistic King has given us a private audience! We should first seek to silently adore Him. Our missal/hymnal in the pews has a wonderful collection of classic prayers from the treasury of our tradition that will allow your heart to moved with great love for Jesus. There is plenty of time to pray while everyone is receiving Communion and while I purify the sacred vessels.

Beyond these formal prayers, we should speak freely to Him, from the depths of our hearts. We should listen attentively to what our Lord is trying to say to us. We can speak to Him as our closest friend, asking Him honestly for the virtues we need to be more like Him. And we should ask Him to reveal to us anything hidden that He will purify by the fire of the Divine Love that now lives within us.

Of course, we thank Him for allowing us to be in His presence and for coming to live in our body and soul, communicating His Divine Life to us. With this gratitude comes the desire to do whatever our Lord asks of us. We promise to make the sacrifices required to allow Him to transform us, but we acknowledge the necessity of His continued assistance. Of course, we pray earnestly for so many needs of the Church and for our neighbors. We should not be afraid to ask our God for too general or too many favors. It is a sign of your trust in His infinite generosity!


