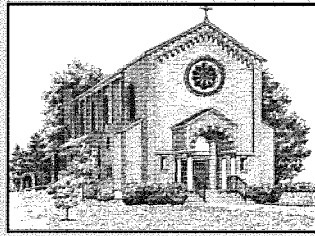


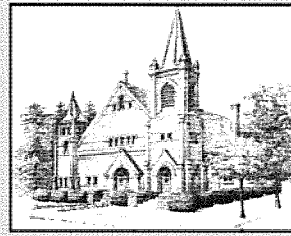

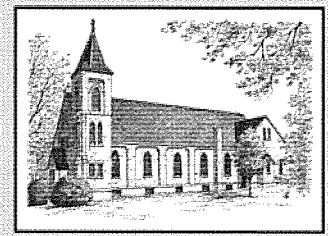

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

In the opening Collect for the Ash Wednesday Mass, we heard Lent referred to as our "campaign of Christian service." This militaristic-type imagery is common throughout history in relation to the Church on earth in reference to the struggle against sin and for true freedom in our soul and in our conscience. We are given this time of year precisely for this purpose, and in solidarity with Christians throughout the world.

I offer you this brief excerpt from the writings of Dom Prosper Guéranger, the great 19th century Abbot of Solesmes, in France, in his monumental work, *The Liturgical Year*. Here, the abbot shows us the significance of the forty-day period into which we have now embarked, and how God has consistently given us examples throughout history:



"Let us remember the forty days and forty nights of the deluge (Genesis 7:12) sent by God in His anger, when He repented that He had made man, and destroyed the whole human race with the exception of one family. Let us consider how the Hebrew people, in punishment for their ingratitude, wandered forty years in the desert, before they were permitted to enter the promised land (Numbers 14:33). Let us listen to our God commanding the Prophet Ezekiel to lie forty days on his right side, as a figure of the siege which was to bring destruction to Jerusalem (Ezekiel 4:6)."

"There are two persons in the Old Testament who represent the two manifestations of God: Moses, who typifies the Law; and Elijah, who is the figure of the Prophets. Both of these are permitted to approach God: the first on Sinai (Exodus 24:18), the second on Horeb (1Kings 19); but both of them have to prepare for the great favor by an expiatory fast of forty days."

"With these mysterious facts before us, we can understand why it is that the Son of God, having become Man for our salvation and wishing to subject Himself to the pain of fasting, chose the number of forty days. The institution of Lent is thus brought before us with everything that can impress the mind with its solemn character, and with its power of appeasing God and purifying our souls. Let us, therefore, look beyond the little world which surrounds us, and see how the whole Christian universe is, at this very time, offering forty days' penance as a sacrifice of propitiation to the offended Majesty of God; and let us hope that, as in the case of the Ninivites, He will mercifully accept this year's offering of our atonement, and pardon us our sins."

We thank God for this Lenten Season which has just begun, and we now march together towards the glory of Easter.

REMEMBER TO KEEP THESE LENTEN REGULATIONS

Traditionally, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving. The following are various Lenten regulations:

Good Friday—along with Ash Wednesday, this is a day of **Fast & Abstinence from meat**. Everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are limited to one full meal on this day.

All Fridays of Lent—Fridays of Lent are days of **Abstinence from Meat**. All those 14 & up are bound to *abstain* from meat.

Other Weekdays of Lent—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial (like giving up something difficult) are recommended.






