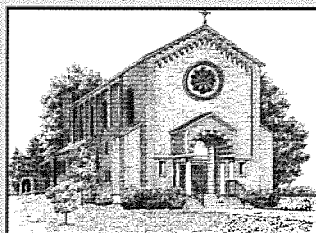
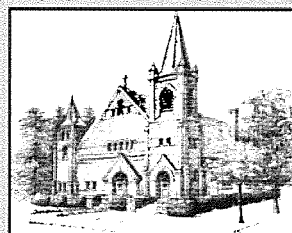


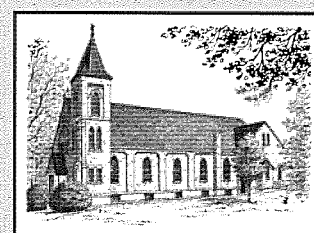

**ST. PETER'S ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH at the CHURCHES of ST. DOMINIC, ST. FELIX, and ST. FRANCIS  
FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

We begin this Holy Week with Palm Sunday, and we walk with our Lord through the final days of His earthly life. On Tuesday of this week, the priests of the Diocese will gather at the Cathedral to celebrate the Chrism Mass with the bishop, as we renew our priestly promises, and the bishop blesses and consecrates the holy oils to be used throughout the coming year. The Chrism Mass will be at 6:00pm, Tuesday, April 12, and anyone can attend. It is a beautiful celebration of the Priesthood and of the priests' union with the bishop. It is always a very joyful occasion in the midst of Holy Week.

As we turn our thoughts and meditation towards the Passion of the Lord, we feel the horror of an innocent man condemned to death. And He knew, the whole time, exactly what He was doing, what had to happen so that the Scriptures would be fulfilled.

We begin this Holy Week in the same way that our Lord began this week so long ago: with a procession and the people chanting, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" As the Archangel Gabriel told Mary long before that first Holy Week "He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end" (Luke 1:32-33) they recognized Him as their King, yet by the end of the week, we find that His throne is a Cross.

While the crowds hailed Jesus as their King on that Sunday, waving palm branches and welcoming Him into Jerusalem it was on Friday of that week when the crowds turned on Him. Even Pontius Pilate would back down to the crowd "So he released the man who had been imprisoned for rebellion and murder, for whom they asked, and he handed Jesus over to them to deal with as they wished" (Luke 23:25). This is the world that would rather destroy Innocence itself and release a murderer, than see in Jesus the face of the Father whom He came to reveal.

Yet, even in His condemnation by Pilate, and His march to Golgotha, we see how He continues to reveal the nature of God in His own Flesh. One of the most profound scenes in the Gospel occurs on the Cross, as Innocence Himself is crucified between two criminals. As His "charge" against Him hangs above His head ("The King of the Jews") he shows that it is from the Cross that He reigns as the Merciful King of the world. One thief mocks Him, the other thief recognizes in the bloody and broken body of Jesus, the One who can save him from his sins: "Then he said, 'Jesus remember me when you come into your kingdom.' He replied to him, 'Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise'" (Luke 23:42-43). The crowds on Palm Sunday knew they had their King with them, they just did not know what kind of King He was.

We have this very privileged time to walk with our Lord this week. We will celebrate the Institution of the Most Holy Eucharist on Thursday, then go to Calvary with Our Lord on Good Friday. Finally, we plunge into the darkness of Holy Saturday and then live in the light of the Resurrection. The most important week of our spiritual life is upon us *Behold the wood of the Cross, on which is hung our salvation. Come, let us adore!*


