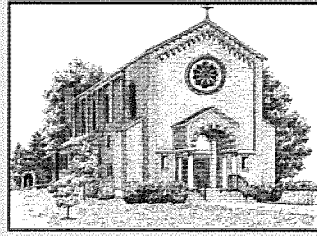
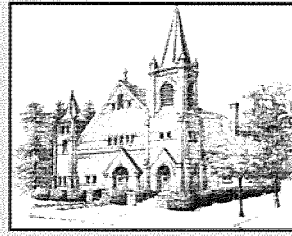


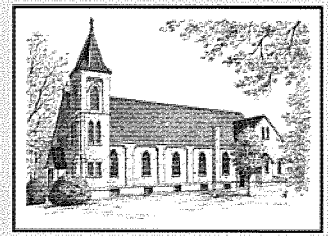

**ST. PETER'S ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH at the CHURCHES of ST. DOMINIC, ST. FELIX, and ST. FRANCIS**

**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

In the traditional liturgical calendar, the final two weeks of Lent were known as "Passiontide," beginning with the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent as the "First Sunday of the Passion." The most noticeable thing about this weekend is that you will see the statues covered, hidden from view by violet cloth. By now you may be familiar with this, but I imagine it is a bit surprising when you walk into the church and see it again.

So why would we do this? It seems like a lot of trouble for about two weeks of decoration. First, we recall why we have statues. We have statues and other images to raise our minds and hearts to the realities they represent. We are, in some way, already in the presence of these saints as we worship at the altar, while they reign in heaven. Since we are composed of both body and soul, we use our senses to move our minds to invisible (insensible) reality. We are all familiar with the way images or music can move us in a certain way. Whether in our churches or in our homes, we try to build an environment that facilitates the worship of God through holy images, statues, etc.

So, back to Passiontide. The traditional Gospel for the First Sunday of the Passion was John 8:46-59. At the end of that passage we read: "They therefore took up stones to cast at Him; *but Jesus hid Himself, and went out from the temple.*"

We are entering more deeply into the Passion of Our Lord, until we must enter into His Death (and Resurrection!) as well. We begin Lent by suspending the singing of the *Gloria* and of the *Alleluia*. The music is toned down, there are no flowers decorating the altar. These things are all taken from us as we seek to gradually strip ourselves of our vices and bad habits as Lent continues. This is represented liturgically in the ways mentioned. We are reminded, as well, of how Our Lord's divinity was hidden at the time of His Passion and Death.

By covering the statues, we take it a step further in our sensory deprivation. Imagine our Lord imprisoned after the Last Supper, on the night He was betrayed. He remains in a dungeon all night, deprived of food and water, chained to the wall, treated as a common criminal. He had already prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane that the Father would take the cup of suffering from Him, but of course He submits to the will of the Father. We enter into that darkness with Him in preparation for the Passion.

Finally, having been deprived of all these things, at the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night, we are deprived of light itself. We are left in complete darkness, the tabernacle emptied on Holy Thursday, His Presence gone. And yet in that moment is when the true Light comes. The Paschal Candle processes into the church with the proclamation, "The Light of Christ." And we respond, "Thanks be to God." Then the Exsultet is chanted, and it is finally Easter. The *Gloria* and *Alleluia* are restored to the Mass, and the joy of the Resurrection fills the hearts of the faithful and brings hope to the world.

Let us enter deeply into the Passion of our Lord in these final days of Lent, and so more joyously celebrate the glory of Easter.

**REMEMBER TO KEEP THESE LENTEN REGULATIONS**

Traditionally, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving. The following are various Lenten regulations:

**Good Friday**—along with Ash Wednesday, this is a day of *Fast & Abstinence from meat*. Everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are limited to one full meal on this day.

**All Fridays of Lent**—Fridays of Lent are days of *Abstinence from Meat*. All those 14 & up are bound to *abstain* from meat.

**Other Weekdays of Lent**—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial and more prayer, and almsgiving, are forms of penance.




