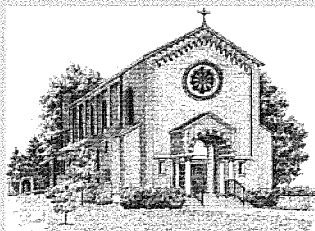


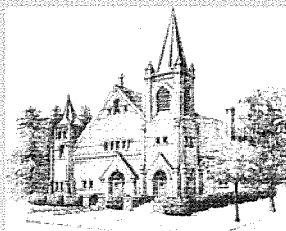

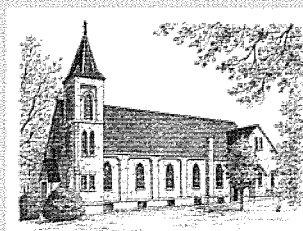

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Lately I've been thinking about the concept of suffering, its purpose, and redemptive value. Of course, the Church has been contemplating this for a long time, and the Psalms (and Job) certainly give their own expressions to this common human experience and how it relates to our all-loving God. In John Paul II's 1984 Apostolic Letter *Salvifici Doloris* (On Redemptive Suffering), he describes all the various dimensions of human suffering and how Scripture and the Tradition have understood it in light of our Redemption in Christ. I highly encourage you to read it.

One of the most encouraging aspects of the "Gospel of Suffering" (sections 25-27) is that we never suffer alone: "Christ does not explain in the abstract the reasons for suffering, but before all else he says: 'Follow me! Come! Take part through your suffering in this work of saving the world, a salvation achieved through my suffering! Through my Cross.' Gradually, *as the individual takes up his cross*, spiritually uniting himself to the Cross of Christ, the salvific meaning of suffering is revealed before him. He does not discover this meaning at his own human level, but at the level of the suffering of Christ." (*Salvifici Doloris*, 26)

But it is Our Mother Mary who went before us, to whom we are united as her children, whose heart was pierced with indescribable sorrows, who was first united to the Cross. John Paul II tells us:

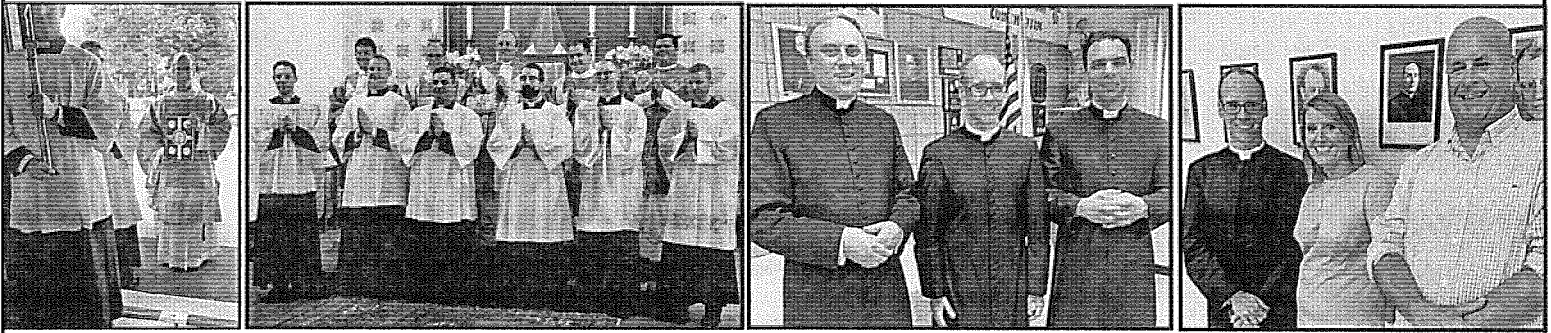
"This is not all: the Divine Redeemer wishes to penetrate the soul of every sufferer through the heart of his holy Mother, the first and the most exalted of all the redeemed. As though by a continuation of that motherhood which by the power of the Holy Spirit had given him life, the dying Christ conferred upon the ever Virgin Mary a *new kind of motherhood*—spiritual and universal — towards all human beings, so that every individual, during the pilgrimage of faith, might remain, together with her, closely united to him unto the Cross, and so that every form of suffering, given fresh life by the power of this Cross, should become no longer the weakness of man but the power of God." (*Salvifici Doloris*, 26)

Let St. Joseph (in this great Year of St. Joseph), united in mind and heart to the Mother of God in the bond of marriage, be your solace and your comforter in your trials.

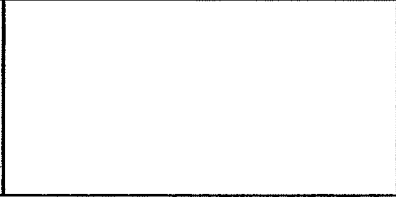

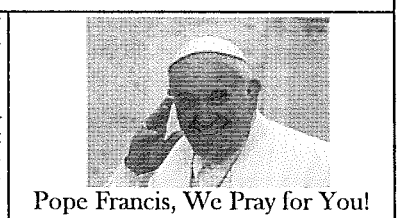
