**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

The other day I was reading an article that contained this quotation (below) from Fr. Jean-Pierre de Caussade's *Abandonment to Divine Providence*. It is a classic book that I highly recommend to all.

The quotation I read made me think about the struggle that so many often have of focusing on so many things that are outside of their control rather than on the things that are right in front of them. Sometimes we can become angry at the way things are in our country and in our Church today. That is certainly understandable. However, we can never ignore the question, "How do I become holy?" "How will I be saved?" "How do I go about the work of sanctification in the midst of all this?"

Perhaps we worry about so many things outside of us, and outside of our control, because it is just easier to "fix" things on the outside than on the inside. Perhaps we just need good discernment as to what needs our attention and what does not.

Here is what Fr. Caussade says about the work of our sanctification:

"If the work of our sanctification presents, apparently, the most insurmountable difficulties, it is because we do not know how to form a just idea of it. In reality, sanctity can be reduced to one single practice, fidelity to the duties appointed by God. Now this fidelity is equally within each one's power whether in its active practice, or passive exercise. The active practice of fidelity consists in accomplishing the duties which devolve upon us whether imposed by the general laws of God and of the Church, or by the particular state that we may have embraced. Its passive exercise consists in the loving acceptance of all that God sends us at each moment." (Book 1, Chapter 1, Section 3)

*There is one single practice: fidelity to the duties appointed by God.* Whatever our state of life happens to be (priest, married, mother or father, single, widowed, etc...) we all have a role appointed to us by God for our sanctification and for the sanctification of those entrusted to us. This should be consoling for us. Do you have children? Teach them the Faith. Pray for them and for your spouse. Even if you have no children or grandchildren, you are part of this parish and so we will all benefit from your prayers and sacrifices. Sometimes someone may be suffering so much that it is difficult to pray because of the devastation. They need to know that they are being lifted up by the prayers of the people with whom they worship.

This is part of what it means to be part of a *Living Body*, the Body of Christ. We offer our sufferings for each other's sanctification, we fulfill our duties that God has put right in front of us in order to sanctify and secure our portion of this Body, and we worship our God by uniting ourselves to the sacrifice of Our Lord on the Cross as a perfect offering to the Father.


