FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

The topic of dryness or "aridity" in our prayer life was clearly one that was important for so many people, as I was told. I was happy to hear that was helpful. This week, we can take a look at "scrupulosity" and "scruples" as a spiritual condition from which some people suffer. Even if one does not suffer from scruples, it is still possible to have some of those tendencies.

First, because of the connection between body and soul, our physical states can and do affect our spiritual state. Someone who may suffer from a type of anxiety or nervous depression may have difficulty making moral judgements without thinking he or she has sinned, yet without being able to give solid reasons for thinking so. On a moral level, someone who has a meticulous type personality might get lost in details and seek *absolute certitude* in all things.

It can also happen that one has an underlying concept of God, not as a just judge, but as a merciless judge. God is both just and merciful, but we should not confuse *feelings* for *consent* when it comes to thoughts that come to our mind that may be sinful. It can often happen that certain thoughts come into our head and linger there a while. Yes, we should do what we can to push them out, to turn our minds towards what is holy and good. If we lament such thoughts, or even find horror in them, or reject them once we actually think about what is happening, that is a good indication that we have not sinned. However, we can take those opportunities to trust in God's mercy all the more and, when we come to confession next, to bring those temptations to our Lord, lay them at His feet, and He will take care of them.

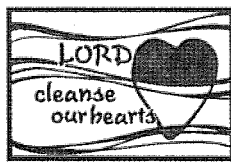
Second, scruples can come from without as well, that is, either from God or from the devil. God can allow us to suffer such things as a cure for our pride, and specifically *perfectionistic* tendencies. God certainly calls us to a life of perfection: "Be you therefore perfect, as also your heavenly Father is perfect" (Matthew 5:48). Exactly what "perfection" entails can be discussed at another time. "Perfectionism," on the other hand, is an aspect of pride and self-reliance. Here, we are afraid of sinning, not because we love God or even so much that we fear hell, but that we did not live up to the expectations we set for ourselves. It is a fear of failure which ultimately comes about because we have not yet relied on Our Lord to uphold us and protect us. As we can see, the devil can also be a source of scruples by creating turmoil in our souls by persuading us that we are in a state of mortal sin when we may not be, or even to engage in self-destructive behavior precisely because of these perfectionistic tendencies that we cannot sustain.

Next week I will continue this discussion with the distinction between a scrupulous conscience and a true, delicate conscience, and also the advantages of facing such trials. As always, *trust* in the grace that our Lord desires to pour out upon us to bring us consolation and peace.


