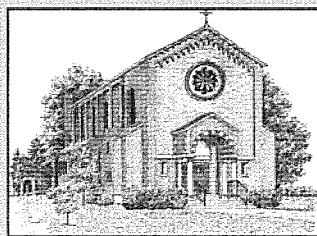
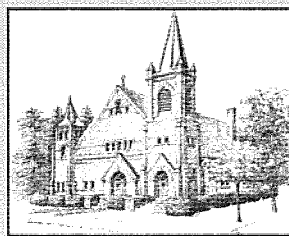


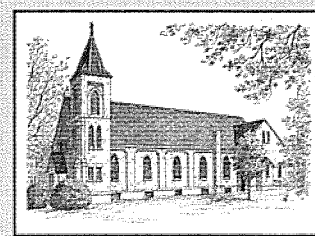

**ST. PETER'S ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH at the CHURCHES of ST. DOMINIC, ST. FELIX, and ST. FRANCIS**

**FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

We begin this first Sunday of the New Year 2022 with the Epiphany of the Lord and the visit of the Magi with their gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. They came to *adore the Lord*, knowing that *this child* is worthy not merely of the veneration given to a great king, but worthy of the *adoration* that is due to God alone.

*They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures* (Matthew 2:11). A good New Year's resolution would be to spend more time in Eucharistic Adoration. We have three evenings each week where our Lord is enthroned on our altar, exposed for all to see and to adore. It is our opportunity to come before him like the Magi, the same God whom they adored, and bring to Him our own gifts.

What are the gifts we have? The gift we bring is nothing less than ourselves. This is what we offer to our Lord in adoration. We come to Him simply because *He is God* present to us on our altars. The natural question may be, "That sounds like a good thing to do, but what do I actually do while I am at adoration?" Good question. It is difficult for us to not be "doing something." We often think we need to accomplish something tangible in order to think we "did something." You do not necessarily need to do anything. It is like enjoying being in the presence of someone we love. Sometimes just being in their presence is enough. And it can go by too fast.

When it comes to our time in adoration of our Eucharistic Lord, it can happen that Our Lord gives us sensible consolations, "good feelings," from being close to Him and in conversation with Him. However, it is not about our feelings. It is about our Faith. At some point those good feelings may not be there, and if we relied solely on those feelings, we may then feel lost. Yet we cling to God by faith, knowing that His infinitely loving Presence will never leave us: "and behold I am with you all days, even to the consummation of the world" (Matthew 28:20).

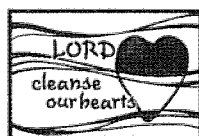
It is difficult to spend a half hour or an hour in adoration at first. We are not expected to be able to be in constant dialogue with God. Even the great saints and other spiritual writers advise us to have a topic or a text upon which to meditate. An hour in adoration may look like this, for example: 15 minutes addressing God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, then the Blessed Virgin Mary, then your guardian angel, and finally patron saints. Speak to each of them acknowledging their presence too and thanking them for the graces they have given to you or obtained for you. Next, 15 minutes reading the Scriptures for the day's Mass and meditating upon them. Then 15 minutes of other spiritual reading. I recommend *Imitation of Christ* by Thomas A. Kempis, or *Divine Intimacy* by Fr. Gabriel of St. Mary Magdalen. There are many great classics to choose from. Finally, 15 minutes of silence, speaking to our Lord present in the Host, giving Him your cares and concerns, your love and affections, and perhaps most importantly, *listening to Him* in the depths of that silence.

That is simply an example of how an hour might be spent. Everyone has to find a rhythm that will be beneficial for them at this particular point in their spiritual life and given the time they have to spend in adoration. Let us resolve to give our Lord a little more of one of the most precious things we have: our time.

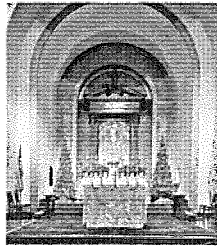


