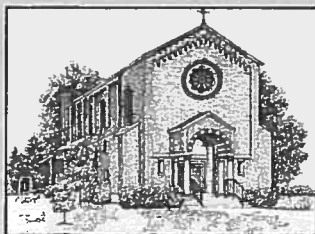


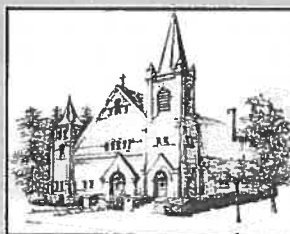

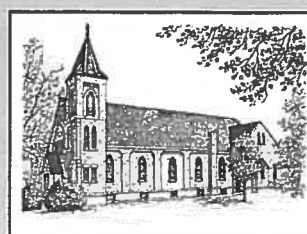

**ST. PETER'S ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH at the CHURCHES of ST. DOMINIC, ST. FELIX, and ST. FRANCIS
FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO**

Happy Advent to you all! May you prepare during these next few weeks to welcome the Lord Jesus into the world, first into our own hearts, then at the end of time. At this point, while still in November, we remember the faithful departed in our prayers, and this brings us to the next prayer in the Roman Canon:

"Remember also, Lord, your servants N. and N., who have gone before us with the sign of faith and rest in the sleep of peace. Grant them, O Lord, we pray, and all who sleep in Christ, a place of refreshment, light and peace. Through Christ our Lord. Amen."

With this beautiful prayer we pray for all the dead at each Mass. We have been seeing throughout this series of articles just how many petitions are contained within the Roman Canon. No one is left out of our prayers during Mass. The Church uses her greatest prayer, and all her power, to bring all souls to heaven.

We can first notice the symmetry of the Roman Canon. Prior to the consecration, we had the three-part prayer which was preceded by the *Memento* of the Living. After the consecration, we have a three-part prayer to offer the Divine Victim to the Father, followed by the *Memento* of the Dead. In the prayer for the living, we pray *with* the Church on earth for all our needs. In the prayer for the dead, now that we are in the presence of the Living God on the altar, we pray *for* all those who have gone before us.

The beautiful movement between the previous prayer and this prayer encompasses all Heaven, earth, and now Purgatory. In the last prayer, we looked up to see God's angel taking our offering to the throne of Heaven. In this prayer immediately following, we ask for those heavenly graces to be poured out upon the Church Suffering, as they await their final purgation. It is our duty, in charity, to assist them.

The words used in this prayer express hope in the resurrection of the just: "sign of faith"; "rest"; "sleep"; "peace"; "refreshment"; "light". The prayer is specifically directed towards those who have died in a state of grace, cleansed from all grave sin, but have not yet attained complete and total purification. So while the souls in Purgatory are being cleansed by that purifying fire, they are also in a state of joy, knowing already that they are among the just who will see the Lord's face.


Finally, this prayer is another opportunity to explicitly pray for your loved ones or anyone else who has died, especially those who have no one to pray for them. After the words, "rest in the sleep of peace," the priest is instructed to pause and pray for certain people. If the Mass is said for someone who has died, I reiterate that name. Also, I pray, "for all those who have died for whom the people here are praying." I do that to cover all your intentions at that moment as well. This is one more way to 'actively participate' in the Mass, as this is the offering of the Church on earth to our Father in Heaven.

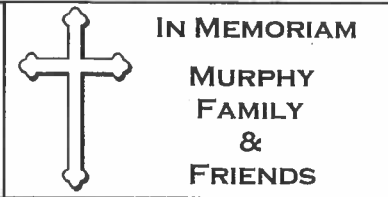

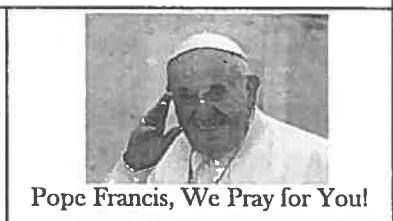
