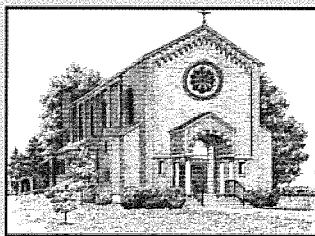
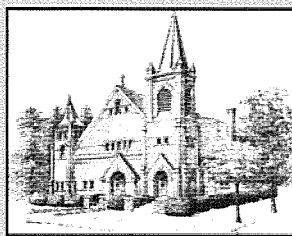


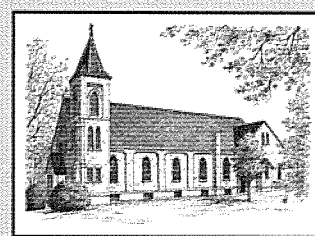

On this *Laetare Sunday*, now halfway through the season of Lent, I simply want to thank all involved for the glorious celebration of the Solemnity of St. Joseph, on Saturday, March 19. From those who made the food, who set up and took down the Parish Center and altar, and certainly all those who attended and who had prayed for a successful event, I give my heartfelt gratitude. To see our Parish Center completely filled (and to have 180 people at Mass!) filled me and everyone there with so much joy on that evening. It was how I imagined parish life should be.

I will take this opportunity to inform you of some future opportunities for special liturgical celebrations that you should mark on your calendar:

**Sunday, April 24, *Divine Mercy Sunday*:** we will expose the Blessed Sacrament after the noon Mass at St. Dominic. Confessions will be heard until about 3:00pm, and then will sing the Divine Mercy Chaplet, followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

**Sunday, June 19, *Corpus Christi*:** we will have the noon Mass at *St. Felix* on this day, followed by a procession with the Blessed Sacrament through the streets of Clifton Springs, down E Main St, and around the block, back to the church. We will then continue the celebration with a parish picnic in the park. More information is forthcoming.

**REMEMBER TO KEEP THESE LENTEN REGULATIONS**

Traditionally, the Lenten season is a time of penance, prayer, the reception of the sacraments, charity and almsgiving. The following are various Lenten regulations:

**Good Friday**—along with Ash Wednesday, this is a day of **Fast & Abstinence from meat**. Everyone between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive are limited to one full meal on this day.

**All Fridays of Lent**—Fridays of Lent are days of **Abstinence from Meat**. All those 14 & up are bound to *abstain* from meat.

**Other Weekdays of Lent**—There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial and more prayer, and almsgiving, are forms of penance.




