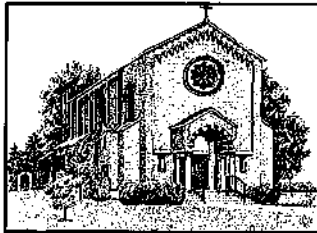

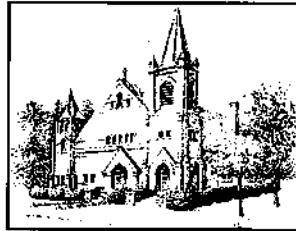

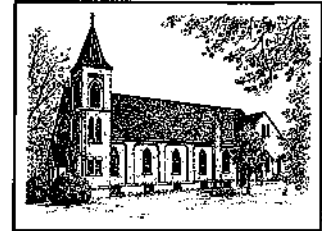

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

This weekend we celebrate the First Communion of seven of our young children. It is always a precious moment, and one of my favorites throughout the whole liturgical year. They have also just received their First Penance on Saturday. It is one of my greatest privileges as a priest to absolve them and to give them the Bread of Life for the first time. They may never again be as pure or as holy as this moment, so we are witnessing those who are truly fit for heaven. It is a real marvel to catch this glimpse of what God does for these souls who love Him.

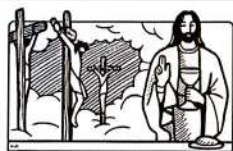
As we are now in the second half of May, the month of Mary, and looking forward to *Corpus Christi*, we should reflect on Mary as the first adorer of the Body of Christ. Her body was the first Tabernacle for the living God, the Ark of the Covenant, the Gate of Heaven. We should try to imagine the inexpressible joy that she and St. Joseph must have felt in adoring the face of God in their child.

The love of His Holy Face did not change in substance as the years went on, but only in its form. After Christ ascended into heaven, to reign at the right hand of the Father, that adoration continued on this earth in the Most Holy Eucharist: "And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Matthew 28:20). In this Blessed Sacrament, Mary could adore her Son and her God with that same intimacy that she had always known between her soul and God. She desires to share that with us as well. As the first and perfect adorer of Christ, she is the model for us who so desire to see His Face, to hear His voice, and to receive His healing grace. See in her Immaculate Heart a perfect love for our Eucharistic Lord!

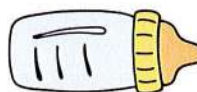

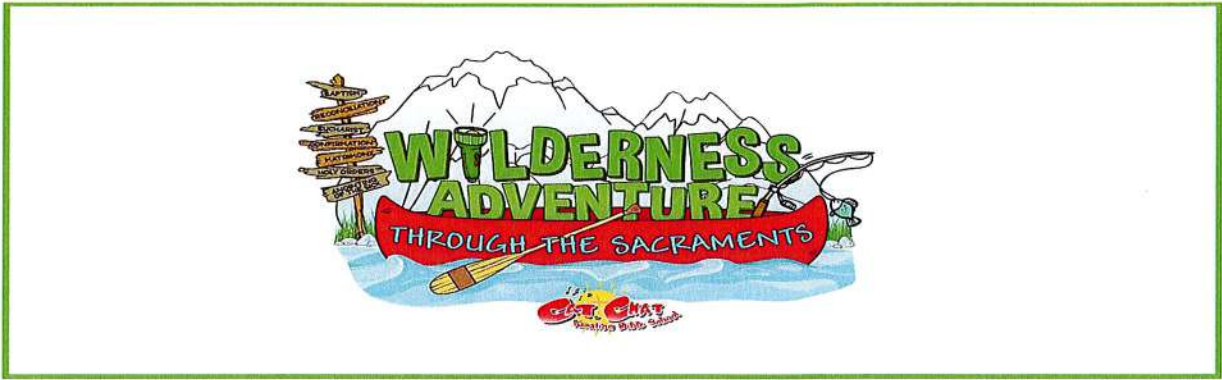
