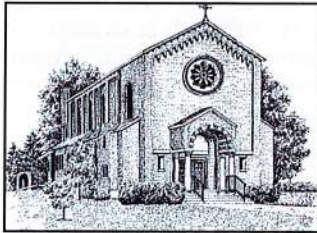

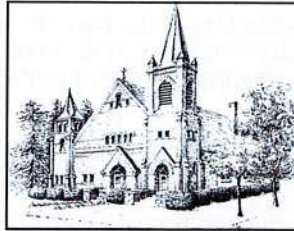

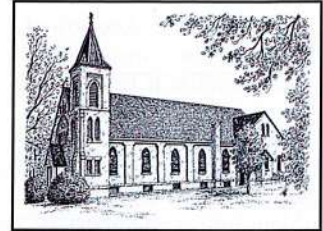

## FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

We now enter the month of June, dedicated to our devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion brings us so close to the humanity of Our Lord whose Heart, because his humanity is united to the Divine Nature (God), is a Divine Heart. Every time His Heart beats, it is *God's Heart that is beating* for love of humanity. And His Heart still beats for love of us as He reigns, glorified, at the right hand of the Father.

This also means the summer months are upon us and we will have all kinds of opportunities for fun activities and travel. We must, nevertheless, give God the priority in all our plans. This means making our plans around when and where to attend the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, to give God the worship that we owe Him, and receive His graces that He so desires to give us. It is very easy to be distracted with the nice weather and with all our plans such that we may skip Mass once, then twice, then the whole summer goes by us without giving much thought to our true identity as sons and daughters of God who should desire to give God true worship before all else.

I write this now not only because it is summer, but because every once in a while I hear people say things such as, "Missing Mass is only a venial sin anyways." The first problem with such a statement is that we should never be willing to deliberately commit even a venial sin and pretend it does not matter. Second, the statement is simply false. **The obligation to attend Mass is a *grave obligation*.**

Pope St. John Paul II, in his Apostolic Letter *Dies Domini* (The Day of the Lord; Pentecost Sunday, May 31, 1998) gives us such a beautiful teaching on all the various aspects of the importance of Sunday as the Day of the Lord and how it is to be kept holy. I can write several articles on this one Letter because it is so rich in its teaching of the importance of the Lord's Day, but one paragraph, in particular, stands out at this point:

"For this presence to be properly proclaimed and lived, it is not enough that the disciples of Christ pray individually and commemorate the death and Resurrection of Christ inwardly, in the secrecy of their hearts. Those who have received the grace of baptism are not saved as individuals alone, but as members of the Mystical Body, having become part of the People of God. It is important therefore that they come together to express fully the very identity of the Church, the *ekklesia*, the assembly called together by the Risen Lord who offered his life 'to reunite the scattered children of God'" (John 11:52; *Dies Domini*, §31).

It is worth reading the whole letter, but getting to the point, John Paul II, in paragraph 47, references the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, §2181, which states: "The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor. *Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin*" (emphasis mine). Besides Sundays, the Church's precept includes all other holy days of obligation, for example, the Ascension of the Lord, which we just celebrated a couple weeks ago.

As noted in the quotation from the *Catechism*, when people are truly unable to make it to Mass due to sickness/injury, caring for a sick loved one who cannot be left alone, or some other unfortunate circumstance, then the obligation would not apply to that person. When in doubt, just ask me and I can dispense you, if appropriate, to ease your conscience. However, if someone is in a situation where he deliberately did not attend Mass, that is a grave/mortal sin, as the *Catechism* states. One would have to go to Confession before receiving Holy Communion again, as would be the case with any grave sin.

There is also a startling habit with some who leave the church immediately after receiving Holy Communion. The Mass concludes when I venerate the altar after the final blessing. Emergencies or some exceptional circumstances are understandable, but simply not wanting to spend a few more minutes in the church is not an acceptable way to treat our Lord Who just fed you with His very own Body and Blood. We should take those precious moments to offer God our gratitude for His gift to us. The hymnal/missal in the pews offers many beautiful prayers to assist you in those few minutes of thanksgiving to our good and all-loving God.

None of this is meant to scare people. The Church places certain obligations on us because it is for our good. It is part of *who we are as the baptized* to come together to worship God as He told us to do. The Church, as our Mother, guides us to what will be best for us, and so she gives us certain disciplines – the laws on fasting and abstinence, and marriage, are other examples – to guide us to an integral Christian life. I wish more people knew the beauty and peace of the Sacrament of Confession. The confessional is where we find mercy, healing, and consolation. This is why I offer confessions five days per week.

We all know from our own experience that, even in our relationships, we do not always act purely out of love and great enthusiasm. We have our ups and downs. Sometimes we do things simply because we have to do them. This is certainly not ideal, but it is part of being human. Our feelings may change from day-to-day, week-to-week, or month-to-month. The point is that it is Our Lord who *forever remains constant*. He is always there waiting for us, taking all of our needs and cares upon Himself, ready to purify us, heal us, and pour out His very life into our hearts.

Thank you, all, for your love for this great parish we have and in this month of June, may we continue to grow ever deeper into the Heart of Our Lord Jesus Christ.


