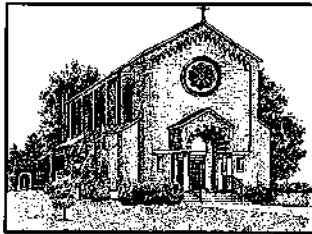




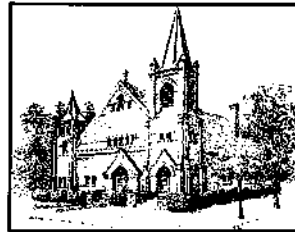

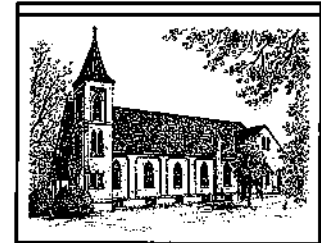

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

*O God, who see how your people
faithfully await the feast of the Lord's Nativity,
enable us, we pray,
to attain the joys of so great a salvation,
and to celebrate them always
with solemn worship and glad rejoicing. Through our Lord Jesus Christ....*

Finally, we see the end of Advent approaching, and therefore the coming of the Lord on Christmas. We refer to this Sunday as “*Gaudete*,” which means, “Rejoice.” It comes from the first words of the Entrance Antiphon: “*Rejoice* in the Lord always; again I say, *Rejoice*.” This comes from St. Paul’s Letter to the Philippians and signals to us that, in the midst of a penitential season, today there is cause for rejoicing. It is not simply the calendar that shows us this, but the decorations in our churches as well. The most obvious of the sensible things is the rose-colored vestments, accompanied by the rose candle on the Advent wreath, flowers make their return to the altar, and I am even using rose-scented incense – in at least one of the churches – to complete the experience.

The rose vestments and the return of flowers to the altar for this week signal to us that something is different now. Indeed, there is something different. The Lord is nearer now than He was before. Advent is now exactly half-way through, and we are granted a reprieve from the penitential feel and look of the Mass (violet vestments, no flowers or other decorations). The Church, through her liturgy, encourages us to rejoice at this time at the coming of the Lord. Do we not have such joy and anticipation when we expect the arrival of a loved-one whom we have not seen in a while? With Christmas approaching, I am sure many are preparing for family members coming from out of town whom they may only see once or twice a year. There is a joy in that anticipation of a reunion with someone you love. That’s the tenor of the Mass for this weekend.

However, there is also still yet a note of sorrow in not fully possessing the One we love. We look forward to His coming, but He is not yet here. We are given a little taste of the joy of Christmas that awaits us before we are plunged back into the final two weeks of Advent.

Our Collect this week speaks again of salvation, but instead of the coming Judgment upon the world, we are reminded of the *waiting* and *expectation* and *anticipation* that is part of the Christian life. Have we been spending this Advent in that joyful expectation of the coming of Christ?

Prosper Guéranger, O.S.B., in his famous work *The Liturgical Year*, gives us this reflection for this Third Sunday of Advent: “Each year He visits thee; each year He brings thee new gifts, wherewith thou may go happily through thy pilgrimage; and to the end of time, He will visit thee, and renew thee, not only with the power of that look wherewith Peter was renewed, but by filling thee with Himself, as He did the ever glorious Virgin, who is the object of thy most tender love, after that which thou bearest to Jesus Himself. We pray with thee, O Church, our mother, and here is our prayer: ‘Come, Lord Jesus! Thy name and Thy remembrance are the desire of our souls: they have desired Thee in the night, yea, and early in the morning have they watched for Thee.’”
