FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Easter! He is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia!

I cannot possibly thank everyone enough, all who helped make our churches and liturgies throughout Holy Week and Easter as beautiful as they were. Thank you to everyone who decorated our churches, sang at the various liturgies, participated in any way at the liturgies. The altar boys did an outstanding job, as always, and I know it is difficult to stay so focused for that long and to carry out our rites with such beauty and precision. It is always worth the effort, for the glory of God and the edification of His people. And thank you for the cards, gifts, and food I have received. I really appreciate it.

As you know, next weekend is Divine Mercy Sunday, the Octave Day of Easter. For all the information you could want on the history of this devotion and the life of St. Faustina, go to www.thedivinemercy.org. It is a great resource page to understand the history of this devotion and to find a brief biography of St. Faustina. She entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy on August 1, 1925, and took the name Sr. Maria Faustina of the Most Blessed Sacrament. In the 1930s she began to have visions and was chosen as the "Secretary" of His Mercy. Today, the *Diary*, where these messages are recorded, is beloved all over the world.

In St. Faustina's diary about the feast, Jesus said:

"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. ... The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy (699)."

The Church attaches a plenary indulgence to the devotions carried out this day, under the usual conditions. Remember, a plenary indulgence is a remission of all temporal punishment due to us for our sins. The Sacrament of Confession, by the absolution of the priest, removes the guilt of sin from our soul, but we still must make satisfaction for our sins.

Here are the conditions for the plenary indulgence for Divine Mercy Sunday:

1. Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within about 20 days before or after the feast
2. Receive Holy Communion
3. Take part in the *Divine Mercy devotions*, or on the feast in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, *recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus*.
4. Be in a state of grace (no mortal sin on your soul); no attachment to any sin, even venial
5. Pray for the intentions of the Pope (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)

For those who cannot go to church or those who are seriously ill, the conditions for the plenary indulgence are:

1. One must not be attached to any sin;
2. Have the intention of fulfilling as soon as possible the three usual conditions of Confession, Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father;
3. Recite the Our Father and the Creed before a devout image of Our Merciful Lord Jesus, pray a devout invocation to the Merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you).

If even the above is impossible:

1. With a spiritual intention unite with those carrying out the prescribed practice for obtaining the Indulgence in the usual way;
2. Offer to the Merciful Lord a prayer and the sufferings of your illness and the difficulties of your life, with the resolution to accomplish as soon as possible the three conditions prescribed to obtain the plenary indulgence.

With such benefits offered to us from heaven, we will again be having the Divine Mercy devotions in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, with Confessions, **next Sunday, starting at 1:30pm at St. Dominic**. This feast day is always a profound encounter with Mercy Itself, so bring friends and family to pray with us!

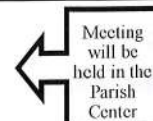
