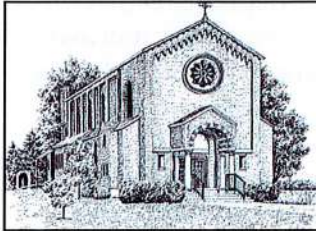

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

Happy Mother's Day to each and all of our mothers throughout the parish and in our lives! It is a blessing to know so many mothers and to know the sacrifices you have made, and continue to make, for your children and those you love. Thank you for all you do!

Before I get back to talking about Mother's Day, I want to thank all of you for your contribution to this Catholic Ministries Appeal. **We have reached our goal!!!** That is quite an achievement given our goal's increase this year. It shows your confidence in our bishop, our diocese, and in me as your pastor. Thank you so much for all you do for our parish!

As we are crowning a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Mother, at a couple of the Masses this weekend, I wanted to write about why we crown her and how she is a model of motherhood. St. Ildephonsus of Toledo, a 7th century bishop wrote a beautiful little book called *Crown of the Virgin*, in which he imagines a crown of gold with a combination of twenty-four precious stones and flowers, each representing some aspect of Mary's beauty, virtue, and eminent sanctity. He begins his praises:

"In the longing of my soul, in the joy of the Holy Spirit, in the most genuine love, and in the Word of Truth, I wish to extol you, to praise you, and to bless you, O Virgin Mary! For you are more radiant than the Sun; in appearance, you are more beautiful; in faith and grace, you are richer. Indeed, you are the most beautiful of all created beings; and serene, radiant, and pleasing, as lovable as the fragrant rose, wholly entrancing and utterly attractive. Such is your dignity and excellence, that were I in possession of the tongues of humans and angels, and understood all hidden mysteries, and had all the knowledge of Scripture, these resources should fail me long before I had succeeded in expressing even the beginnings of the praise due to you. For you indeed are incomparably above all women in beauty, in gracefulness, and in elegance. You surpass all mortals in virtue, grace, and wisdom. You are more glorious than the angels themselves in eminence of dignity, in excellence of holiness, and in command of glory and honor. Exalted above the choirs of angels, above the thrones of the apostles and the prophets, and above all heavenly beings, you sit – crowned as Queen, at the right hand of your most beloved Son!"

If we, in our own praises and devotion to Mary can even come close to how much St. Ildephonsus loves Mary, then we will be doing well. I hope that throughout the month of May, as we crown Mary this weekend, and sing her praises, our love of her will grow, and the brilliance of her sanctity will shine upon us.

And who would not want to honor such a good mother? The perfect disciple of Jesus; the model of all virtues, of humility, of constancy, of contemplation. Regarding our earthly mothers, do we not run to our mother when we need consolation, healing, or when we are in danger? Do we not share our joys, our triumphs, and our concerns? We go to her for counsel and advice, with the assurance that wherever she is we have a home because we are loved.

In the order of grace, the Blessed Virgin Mary gives us life. St. Bernard tell us that since Jesus is the source of all grace, Mary is the channel which carries that grace to us. Our Lord came into this world through her, and so we go to her to find there the love of God. She brings us to Christ as any mother would want to do. Further, as the Church is truly Christ's own Body, into which we are baptized, then Mary is truly the Mother of the Church, and therefore, of each one of us as well. We go to her for healing, consolation, and peace. We share with her our secrets, our desires for the love of God, for peace, healing, and purity. We should ask her to show us how to love her Son more, how to adore Him with more devotion and humility, and allow ourselves to be carried by her to her Divine Son. We are her beloved children and she is our Immaculate Mother.

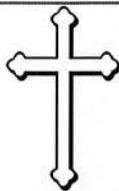
