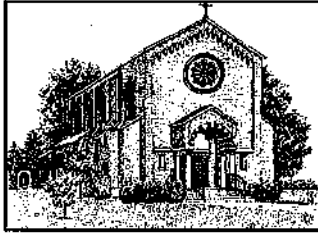

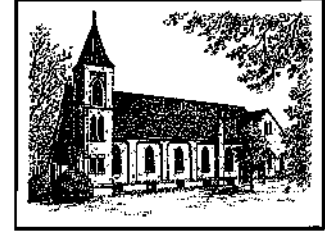

FROM OUR PASTOR, FATHER AMATO

First, I want to wish all of our fathers a very happy Father's Day!

This week I simply want to express my gratitude to all who made the *Corpus Christi* procession possible. Everyone knows how good our altar servers are, how attentive and devout, how precise and dutiful they are in carrying out their roles. I am always very proud of them. And I told all 16 of them (yes, 16 altar boys) how proud I am of them at the beginning of my homily. Thank you to their families who brought them to rehearsal, who bring them to serve each week, and are so devoted to our parish. To all of our parishioners, I am always humbled when I see your continued love and care for our beloved churches.



For *Corpus Christi*, we put all our effort and energies into glorifying our Eucharistic Lord as much as we can. We want people to know how much we love Him and how much He loves all of them. Just as we bring Him out of the church in our own bodies once we receive Him in Holy Communion, so for this procession we bring Him as our King with all the honor and praise we can give him.

I also want to thank the Knights of Columbus for carrying the canopy over the monstrance containing our Eucharistic Lord. Such close proximity to the Presence of God cannot but bless us! A couple of our Knights also led the procession to begin the Mass in full Color Guard attire. That was extra special. But I also have a deep gratitude for another Knight, and our Parish Council Chair, Pat Ryan. He set up the altar of repose and the tent in the cemetery, after being at the rehearsal for over an hour on the Friday prior to the procession.



The music, as always, was superb. We had our choir members from each church in the procession, singing our beautiful Eucharistic hymns. I am always grateful for their efforts and for the time it takes to learn the music and lead us every week.

Finally, I am grateful to Our Lord who allowed me to celebrate such a glorious Mass and lead such a procession. When it was all over, after three Masses and a procession, as everyone was singing "Holy God, We Praise Thy Name," I told Our Lord that I hope He was happy with all that we did for Him; with all the effort and love that we poured out for Him on this beautiful occasion.



Next year, we will try to bring everyone together for an even more unified parish celebration with a parish picnic. We are just beginning to plan, but mark your calendars for Sunday, June 2, 2024.
